**OPEN LETTER 2**

**Dear Sir / Madam,**

Representing the community of Wilda, Poznań, Poland, acting as members of the Rada Osiedla Wilda (Wilda Community Council) which constitutes an administrative supportive unit of the City of Poznań, we hereby AGAIN request your response in connection with harmful actions of SKANSKA POLSKA.

**This is already our second letter to SKANSKA since we have not received any kind of response to the last letter sent on 5<sup>th</sup> July 2019 (attached) which we find outrageous and ignoring!**

As you should be aware already, Your Polish subsidiary damaged, as a result of construction works, as many as 18 European ash trees located alongside the road adjacent to the "Nowy Rynek" Project in Poznań thus ignoring the agreement concluded during a coordination meeting with SKANSKA-POLSKA held already in 2017 during which a method of handling of tree root systems was agreed.

The fact of major and irreversible damages has been confirmed in the report from the expert's study prepared by Mrs. Marzena Suchocka PhD, an arborist specializing in the health of trees in urban areas. **The damages caused by SKANSKA-POLSKA extend beyond the critical point and will lead to their death.** There is no possibility for the ash trees in the Przemysłowa street to regenerate and to recover and they no longer fulfill their natural, aesthetic, economic and social functions.

As the local community, we feel tricked and deceived by SKANSKA. The awareness of Sweden and its population to environmental issues is often highlighted in our country -

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and then, looking at such ignorant and malicious actions of your company in our city, it makes one wonder if double standards are in play.

**We demand that you make your Polish subsidiary compensate for the caused damages by planting a new alley of mature trees with a developed root system and a developed canopy!**

Instead of avoiding responsibility, one should consider the best method to remedy the damages cause - only this will allow SKANSKA to mitigate the damage to its pro-environmental image, as opposed to PR activities carried out by Skanska Polska which are aimed at downplaying and ignoring the problem.

We really hope that our letters will no longer be ignored and you will start to treat us with the whole seriousness and respect adequate to the problem.
